- Immensely involved in implementation of communications plans and campaigns to ensure message alignment, channel optimization, appropriate scheduling, copy creation, design components, performance measurement and other production needs.
- Create engaging content consistent with the organization's brand standards for communications materials, including the ability to write clearly, concisely, and persuasively across multiple channels.
- Lead communications planning for key initiatives including the project management of Pi Phi's publications, establishing, and managing the story lead process, and monitoring communication effort performance.
- Contribute project management expertise and delivery of high-quality communication tools and collateral in support of organizational priorities.
